The Annual CRWA Scholarship Program

The California Rural Water Association is pleased to bring the Annual Scholarship Program for the year 2023. This scholarship is sponsored by our Preferred Provider, Servline, and includes three possible awards:

- \$3,000 award towards formal education (college)
- \$2,000 award towards formal education (college)
- \$1,000 award towards any AWE course(s) provided by CRWA

The scholarships are predicated on the idea that as part of the CRWA family we should be doing as much as we possibly can to fulfill the water need of California's rural communities.

Anyone with an association with CRWA can apply and applications are being accepted from November 1, 2022 through February 15, 2023. The scholarships will be awarded at our EXPO Annual Banquet to be held on Tuesday, April 25, 2023, at Harvey's Lake Tahoe Casino & Resort.

Applicants do not need to attend the EXPO conference to receive a scholarship, but attendance at the conference is highly recommended. CRWA will pay for Lodging and EXPO expenses for winners who do choose to attend the conference.

Applicants will be evaluated on the basis of association with the CRWA family (30 points), field of study relation to the water/wastewater field (50 points), and overall quality and appearance of the application (20 points). Those applying for a formal education award also need to be enrolled in a college and have a minimum GPA of 2.0; if selected, a transcript will be requested.
