



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

· How do I register?

To register as an attendee, please complete the form inside. Additional registration forms are available online at www.calruralwater.org/expo/.

· Why should I attend?

Attendees participate in the Expo to earn necessary contact hours, network with exhibitors and peers, connect with EPA and SWRCB representatives, and have a good time! This year's Expo includes a wide range of classes with topics relevant to water and wastewater operators and administrators.

When can I pick up my registration packet?

Registration packets, including conference materials, a name badge, and an onsite guide, will be available at the registration desk beginning at 6pm on Monday, April 28, 2025.

• Can I register after the April 18, 2025, deadline?

The finalist and the winner will be announced at the CRWA Awards Banquet that evening. The winning system's water will have the opportunity to represent California at the Great American Water Taste Test in Washington D.C. in February 2026!

SYSTEM CRITERIA

Nominations are accepted from water and wastewater systems that are members of CRWA. The system may nominate one operator for each category (water and wastewater) or one operator for both categories. The system must be in compliance, or in the process of becoming compliant, due to the nominee's efforts. Nominations can be submitted by co-workers, management, boards or office staff.

Monday Night Welcome Reception & Mixer


